



M-125/US-24 Improvements Monroe County April - November 2014

What Is Being Done?

Starting this spring, the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will oversee construction on two major corridors in Monroe – M-125 between Jones Street and US-24, and US-24 between Grafton Road and Buhl Road. The following is a list of improvements for each corridor:

M-125

- Resurface 5.2 miles of pavement
- Replace box culverts at four local drains
- Widen the roadway for center left-turn lanes between Sylvan Drive and Standish Drive, between Calvin Drive and just north of Country Drive, and between Heiss Road and Nadeau Road
- Intermittent curb and gutter replacement
- Sidewalk ramp upgrades
- Traffic signal upgrades

US-24

- Resurface just under a mile of pavement
- Widen for a center left-turn lane to match the five-lane section at Grafton Road.
- Drainage upgrades
- Bridge repairs at Stoney Creek

How will traffic be affected?

Construction will be performed in stages to minimize the impact on residents and motorists. At least one lane will be open in each direction on M-125 and US-24.
