

Sanitary Sewer Use Tips

- Do not dump cooking grease and oils down sinks or toilets.
 - Don't flush trash, female sanitary products, disposable diapers, Swiffer cleaning towels, rags, or any fibrous towels down the toilet.
 - Pour water in floor drains and sinks on a regular basis to keep traps full of water.
 - If you have trees around your sewer lateral, set up a preventive maintenance program with a sewer and drain cleaner or plumber to assure roots won't cause a stoppage in your lateral.
 - When you experience a sanitary sewer problem, call the Wastewater Treatment Plant for 24 hour / 7 day service at (734) 241-5926. An experienced crew will respond and assist with diagnosing the problem and give further instruction to resolve the problem at no charge.
