SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
THURSDAY, DECEMBER 17, 2009

Special meeting of the City Council of the City of Monroe, Michigan held on Thursday, December 17, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers.

Present: Council Members Beneteau, Clark, Paisley, McGhee, Molenda (7:08 p.m.), Conner, and Mayor Worrell.

Consent Agenda.

292 Fire Department Grant.

1. Communication from the City Manager submitting a proposal by the Monroe Fire Chief to apply for a Federal Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) grant, and recommending that Council approve the proposal to apply for a SAFER grant.
2. Supporting documents.
3. Action: Accept, place on file and the recommendation be carried out.

Mayor Worrell explained that Council will have dialog on the Fire Department grant now and will seek input from the Fire Chief at a later date because he is unavailable for discussion today. He further added that the decision will be made by the new Council.

George Brown, City Manager explained the specific details about the grant and said that today an extension was given for submitting the grant.

Lt. Hoskins, Monroe Fire Department explained that with both Chief Mominee and Captain DeSloover out of town, and the time allowance for submitting the grant was extended until January 15th, his recommendation would be to speak with the Fire Chief when he returns from vacation.

After discussion, it was the consensus of Council that item 292 would be postponed until Chief Mominee is available for more information.

It was moved by Councilman Paisley and seconded by Councilman McGhee to go into Closed Executive Session at 7:22 p.m., to discuss Collective Bargaining at the request of the City Manager.
