Mayor Worrell explained that one the reasons for the meeting is the discharge of firearms near the trail to the State Park and how it can be controlled.

George Brown, City Manager briefly described where the new section and location of the trail to the State Park is and explained what the hunting laws are for state and private land and where those areas are located in reference to the State Park Trail.

After a brief discussion, there was a consensus that a change to the ordinance is needed.

Tom Ready, City Attorney concluded that a change in the hunting ordinance would involve amending one section, two (2) small paragraphs, of the Ordinance, and it would be done as an ordinary Ordinance amendment.

George Brown, City Manager presented information on a potential funding scenario to re-establish the Community Development and Recreation Director.
