Special meeting of the City Council of the City of Monroe, Michigan held on Wednesday, March 26, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers.

Communication from the Director of Economic and Community Development, submitting a proposed resolution supporting the Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund Application for the River Raisin Heritage Corridor Riverfront Connection, and recommending that City Council authorize and support the submittal of a Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund Acquisition Grant Application for the River Raisin Heritage Corridor Riverfront Connection; in the form of the attached resolution. It was moved by Council Member Molenda and seconded by Council Member Sisk that item 39 be postponed until after the Public Hearing and a reconsideration date be set.
