1. Approval of the Traffic Committee minutes from the September 25, 2013 meeting.

Motion: It was moved by Councilman Hensley and supported by Lt. Morgel to approve the minutes from the September 25, 2013 meeting.

Action: The motion passed unanimously.

2. Request from the Downtown Development Authority through City staff to study lane reconfiguration options for Monroe Street between Third Street and the River Raisin.

Motion: It was moved by Scott Davidson and supported by Dennis Polczynski to recommend that the City Council study this issue.

Action: The motion passed unanimously.

3. Request from citizen Jane Smith of 808 O'Brien Street to again restrict parking to one side of the street for the entire 800 block of O'Brien Street.

Motion: It was moved by Scott Davidson and supported by Councilman Hensley to refer this issue to staff to survey residents and provide technical review back to the committee.

Action: The motion passed unanimously.

4. Request from citizen Harold Caldwell to establish a set street sweeping schedule to coincide with trash collection.

Action: No motion was made, staff will take comments under advisement and report to the City Council or other committees when requested.

5. Request from the Engineering Department to review West Front Street between Smith Street and Harrison Street for the addition of a shared left turn lane and potential left turn prohibition at Smith Street.

Action: No motion was made, staff will review and report back at a later date based on the consensus of the committee.

6. Request from City staff to consider raising the metered parking rates in the downtown area

Motion: It was moved by Scott Davidson and supported by James Crammond to approve the proposed Traffic Control Orders with the new meter rates, and to ask the staff to review options to allow Council to set rates on their own in the future.

Action: The motion passed unanimously.

7. Update from staff on a request from Traffic Committee member Dennis Polczynski to prohibit left turns from Telegraph Road onto Custer Drive in both directions.

Action: No action was necessary, staff review is still underway.

8. Update from staff on a request from citizen Anthony Donofrio to install a left turn arrow at the intersection of West Front Street and South Roessler Street.

Action: No action was necessary, staff review is still underway.
