Incident:

On 01/22/2019 at approximately 8:03PM, Officers of the Monroe Police Department were dispatched to gunshots fired in the 300Blk. of Kentucky Ave. Upon arrival, both an adult female and male victim were located, both sustaining gunshot wounds. Lifesaving measures were performed on the male subject; however, he succumed to his injuries and died. The female victim was transported to a nearby area hospital for treatment for non-life threatening injuries. Detectives of the Monroe Police Department were called to the scene, where it was later determined an altercation had taken place, but the details are still forthcoming. A possible suspect has been developed, but has not been located at this time. This is an active and ongoing investigation.
