**Incident:** UPDATED INFORMATION to HOMICIDE PRESS RELEASE

On 01/22/2019 at approximately 8:03PM, Officers of the Monroe Police Department were dispatched to gunshots fired in the 300Blk. of Kentucky Ave. Upon arrival, both an adult female and male victim were located, both sustaining gunshot wounds. Lifesaving measures were performed on the male subject; however, he succumbed to his injuries and died. The female victim was transported to a nearby area hospital for treatment for non-life threatening injuries.

As of 01/24/2019, the female victim is expected to recover from her injuries. Detectives spoke with the female victim, who positively identified the shooter as Marquis Terrell Evans (07/18/1995). Suspect Evans, who also goes by the name "Marcus" whereabouts are still unknown; however, Detectives are continuing to actively investigate this incident and are seeking information as to his location. Anyone with information regarding the whereabouts of Marquis Evans are urged to call the Monroe Police Department at (734) 243-7500, or Monroe County Central Dispatch at (734) 241-3300. Suspect Evans should be considered armed and dangerous. Attached are recent photographs of Marquis Evans, contained within an Informational Bulletin.

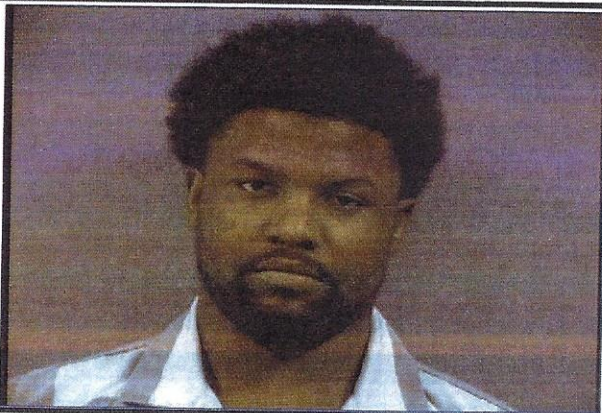
