Incident: Home Invasion / Felonious Assault

On Monday, February 22, 2021 at approximately 5:40AM, Officers of the Monroe Police Department were dispatched to the 300Blk. of Arbor Ave., reference a Home Invasion and Felonious Assault complaint. Officers arrived on scene to discover a 33 year old male victim, injured from a stab wound to his upper arm. Medical personnel arrived and transported the victim to an area hospital for treatment. At this time, he is in stable condition. Officers are actively investigating the circumstaces of this Home Invasion and working with the victim, as well as collecting evidence in this case. The suspect was described as a 35 to 40 year old W/M subject wearing a blue jacket and a black/red winter cap, who had fled the scene prior to police arrival. The suspect's identity is unknown at this time.
