Incident: Single vehicle rollover traffic crash

On Monday, February 22, 2021 at approximately 6:40PM, Officers of the Monroe Police Department were dispatched to northbound I-75 for a single vehicle rollover crash. At the scene, MPD Officers located a pickup truck that had rolled over on the Elm Avenue bridge at Exit 13. The pickup truck came to rest on the roof of the vehicle and the driver, and lone occupant, were located outside of the vehicle. The driver was not injured as a result of the crash and was medically cleared at the scene by MCA paramedics. Officers closed two lanes of traffic for approximately one hour to conduct the investigation. Initial findings suggest alcohol may have been a factor in the crash.
