Incident: Attempted Homicide / Felony Firearm

On 04/14/2021 at approximately 7:50PM, Officers of the Monroe Police Department were dispatched to the area of the 1000Blk. of E. Fifth St., reference reports of multiple gunshots in the area, with a male subject on the ground. Officers arrived and located one 45yr old male victim, who had suffered multiple gunshot wounds to his torso and extremities. The victim was transported to a Toledo, OH. area hospital, where he was treated for his injuries. The victim has been stabilized and is expected to recover.

Through the work of Officers and Detectives on-scene, a suspect was developed. In addition, the 42yr old male suspect was known by the victim and attempts to locate him were made. On the morning of 04/15/2021, the suspect arrived at the Monroe Police Department to speak with Detectives. The suspect was cooperative with police and was subsequently lodged in the Monroe County Jail. Arraignment is expected on Friday, 04/16/2021 in the First District Court of Monroe. The suspect's identity will be released following arraignment. Anyone with information, please contact Detective Mike Merkle or D/Lieutenant Derek Lindsay.
