Incident: Single vehicle personal injury accident

On Friday, May 21st, 2021 at approximately 9:40 pm, Officers of the Monroe Police Department were dispatched to the 1200 block of East Elm Avenue reference a single vehicle personal injury accident. On scene MPD Officers located a passenger car that struck a parked vehicle and then crashed into a utility pole. The vehicle sustained heavy front end damage and the driver was found wedged underneath the dashboard. The driver sustained non-life threatening injuries and was transported to a Toledo Hospital by MCA. Officers diverted traffic off East Elm Avenue for approximately an hour to conduct the investigation. Initial findings suggest alcohol may have been a factor in the crash.
