MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- All applicants must be 21 years of age and a citizen of the United States.
- Must have a diploma from an accredited high school or its equivalent.
- Applicants must be MCOLES certified or certifiable.
- The candidate must possess normal visual acuity.
- Distance vision must be 20/40 or better uncorrected for each eye. 20/20 each eye separate with correction. Visual field must be normal.
- Must be able to pass color vision.
- Prior to being hired, applicants will undergo a complete medical and psychiatric examination.
- A complete background investigation will be completed including education, employment background, personal traits and driving record.
- Applicants will also be tested for illegal drug use as permitted by law.
- An applicant's reputation and work record should be above reproach.
