PUBLIC SAFETY PATROL OFFICER**

The City of Monroe is currently accepting applications for the Public Safety Patrol Officer position. This full-time role involves maintaining order, regulating traffic, protecting life and property, and providing assistance during emergency medical calls and other emergency response activities.

To qualify, applicants must be at least 18 years old and a United States citizen. A high school diploma, GED, or equivalent is required. Additionally, candidates must be Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards (MCOLES) certified, certifiable, or successfully complete a Michigan-recognized police academy. The selection process requires passing a medical exam, psychiatric exam, and background check. A valid Michigan Vehicle Operator's License and a clean driving record are also necessary.

Public Safety Patrol Officers must be able to prepare investigative reports and other documents. Officers are expected to operate emergency vehicles safely during emergency situations. An understanding of relevant laws and policies is necessary to ensure proper conduct during enforcement activities, direct traffic, and serve legal documents, such as subpoenas and warrants.
